

2018> ONLY BUMPER REMOVAL:

- 1. Remove three fixings from the lower wheel arch trim each side, remove two fixings each side found behind trim.
- 2. Remove two fixings around each light cluster, located under the vehicle.
- 3. Remove two vertical fixings central to panel behind number plate.
- **4.** Unplug the wiring loom and carefully remove the rear bumper.

TOWBAR INSTALLATION:

- 1. 2007 2018: Lower the exhaust silencer and support to prevent any damage, locate Towbar mounting points on rear crossmember of vehicle.
- 2. Using item F with item H and item G with item H loosely bolt item B to item A.
- 3. Using item E with item H bolt the Towbar assembly to the existing holes in the rear crossmember of the vehicle.
- **4.** Using item **D** bolt the ball bracket (not supplied in this kit) to item **B**, using Item **J** bolt item **C** to item **A** and fully tighten all fixings ensuring the Towbar is rigid, square and secure.
- 5. Refit the exhaust silencer to hanger.
- 6. 2018>: Remove the central bumper bracket from the rear crossmember and cut out the centre, SEE FIG.1.
- 7. Using item F with item H and item G with item H loosely bolt item B to item A.
- **8.** Using item **E** with item **H** bolt the Towbar assembly to the existing central two holes in the rear crossmember of the vehicle.
- **9.** Using the original fixings bolt the Towbar and the central original bumper bracket to the rear crossmember using the original fixings through the outer holes.
- 10. Using item **D** bolt the ball bracket (not supplied in this kit) to item **B**, using Item **J** bolt item **C** to item **A** and fully tighten all fixings ensuring the Towbar is rigid, square and secure.
- 11. Refit the rear bumper.



Notes:

- 1. For Torque settings see general notes overleaf.
- 2. Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturer's trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
